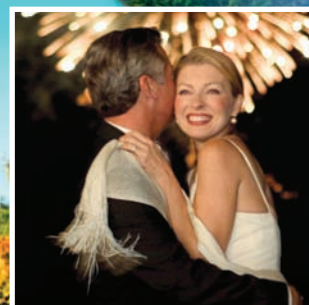

From country stores to covered bridges, and rugged coastlines to remarkable mountains, welcome to New England's back roads.

Day 10: Boston - Southern Vermont

A sightseeing tour of Boston features the Old South Meeting House, gathering place of patriots, the Public Gardens, the Old North Church, Beacon Hill, and the U.S.S. Constitution, the oldest commissioned warship afloat in the world. Later, stop at the famed Faneuil Hall marketplace with its eclectic and tempting assortment of food and shops, before departing for Vermont, known as "The Green Mountain State." En route, you will pass traditional white steeple churches, quaint villages and tree covered mountainsides which in autumn are often ablaze with colour. Today breakfast and dinner will be included.

Day 11: Bennington - Southern Vermont

Enjoy the beauty of Vermont. First, explore the town of Bennington where you will see the gravesite of Robert Frost as well as the historic 306' stone obelisk known as the Bennington Battle Monument. Next, enjoy a highlight as you drive along the famed Molly Stark Trail, where every turn brings a breathtaking vista. Visit Hildene House, the stunning summer home of Abraham Lincoln's eldest son, whose historic home, gardens and farm are set on over 412 picturesque acres. This afternoon arrive at Honoura Winery for a wine and cheese pairing, followed by dinner. Enjoy a presentation on this locally-owned winery's winemaking process – and sample wine during its aging stage to learn more about this fascinating industry. Today breakfast and dinner will be included.

Day 12: Southern Vermont - Burlington

This morning, journey to northern Vermont for a visit to the exceptional Shelburne Museum. This museum showcases a complex of 37 historic buildings, many of which were relocated from other parts of New England, which are now home to vast collections of fine and decorative art, paintings and folk sculptures. The afternoon is at leisure to explore vibrant Burlington. Today breakfast will be included.

Day 13: Burlington - Stowe - Lincoln, New Hampshire

Watch apples transform into cider the old-fashioned way - using a rack and cloth press - during a trip to the Cold Hollow Cider Mill. A visit and tour of Ben & Jerry's Ice Cream Factory teaches you about the ice cream process and ends with a delicious sample of their sweet treats. Next, enjoy a short visit to Stowe, a quintessential New England town, where you will have time to explore. You then journey through the lovely New England countryside to New Hampshire,

your home for the next two nights. Today breakfast and dinner will be included.

Day 14: Lincoln - North Conway - Lincoln

This morning you depart for a full day of sightseeing in the scenic White Mountains of New Hampshire. You will take the Kancamagus Highway, recently declared a Scenic Byway by the U.S. Forest Service, to North Conway where you can stroll through the quaint village before returning to Lincoln. This afternoon, visit the Rocks Estate, home to the North Country Conservation & Education Center. Tour the farm and learn about the history and importance of maple sugaring in the region, including a visit to a virtual tap room. Today breakfast will be included.

Day 15: Lincoln - Boothbay Harbour, Maine

Depart New Hampshire for Maine, arriving in beautiful Boothbay Harbour, the "boating capital of New England." You will view the rugged coastline while on a drive along picturesque Ocean Point Road. Enjoy your afternoon at leisure...perhaps you will stroll through this quaint town or just relax at your hotel. Later tonight, join your fellow travellers for a very special farewell dinner featuring the fresh native lobster for which coastal Maine is renowned. Today breakfast and dinner will be included.

Day 16: Boothbay Harbour - Kennebunkport – Boston.

Today you travel through the seaside community of Kennebunkport, along spectacular Ocean Drive. See Walker's Point, former President George Bush's summer home, which is situated on a rocky promontory, before returning to the Boston airport for your flight back to the UK. Day 16: San Francisco - Oakdale - Sonora

In its Gold Rush heyday, Sonora was the cosmopolitan city of 1848, attracting people from all over the world. Today lunch will be included.

Day 17: Sonora - Yosemite - Sonora

A scenic drive brings you into the awe-inspiring Yosemite National Park. Your tour through Yosemite's amazing waterfalls, unique rock formations, deep valleys, Alpine meadows and pristine wilderness will leave you absolutely awestruck. Today breakfast and dinner will be included.

Day 18: Sonora - Jamestown - Sacramento

Travel to Jamestown to visit Railtown, an 1897 state historic park featuring turn-of-the-century locomotives and railcars. A popular spot for movie makers, "High Noon," "The Virginian," and Petticoat Junction" were filmed here. Arrive in Sacramento where a local guide introduces you to this beautiful city, including a view of Sutter's Fort, the historic Governor's Mansion where Ronald Reagan once resided, and the State Capitol building. Then continue through Old Sacramento's historical district with over 60 restored gold rush era buildings, wooden sidewalks, cobblestone streets and antique gas lamps for a glimpse at what life was like when thousands of "49ers" flocked here during the California Gold Rush. This evening, enjoy a fine dining experience on the Delta King. This stationary restaurant on the Sacramento River is an authentic 285 foot riverboat, christened in 1927. Today breakfast and dinner will be included.

Day 19: Sacramento - Lake Tahoe - Sacramento

Travel over the Sierra Nevada Mountains to the resort gambling town of Lake Tahoe. Upon arrival, enjoy a narrated cruise of spectacular Lake Tahoe aboard the

M. S. Dixie II paddlewheeler. Later, make a quick visit to a nearby casino to try your luck or explore the shops before returning to Sacramento. Today breakfast will be included.

Day 20: Sacramento - Woodland - Sacramento

Travel to Woodland and board the Sacramento River Train to experience a "Great Train Robbery" complete with a Cowboy barbeque picnic-style lunch by the river. The Sacramento River Train boasts a sparkling gold interior reflecting the area's Gold Rush heritage and follows a scenic route along the Sacramento River. En route, be on the lookout for robbers and gunfighters!! Return to Sacramento for leisure time to relax, revisit Old Sacramento or visit the renowned Railroad Museum on your own. Today breakfast and lunch will be included.

Day 21: Sacramento - Napa Valley - Ft. Bragg

Arriving in Napa Valley, board the Napa Valley Wine Train, a splendidly restored 1915 Pullman car, and travel through the picturesque Napa Valley. Blend this with innovative cuisine, an education on wine tasting and beautiful scenery. Later, arrive in Ft. Bragg, an old logging town surrounded by spectacular redwood forests and the Pacific Ocean. Today breakfast and lunch will be included.

The 121 year old Skunk Train is considered one of the best scenic trains in North America. As you learn more about their self-sufficiency and peaceful lifestyle, you will understand how their "life apart" is an expression of their religious faith and

dedication. Tonight, enjoy dinner in the home of an Amish family, for an Amish feast** - a true highlight of your tour. Today breakfast and dinner will be included.

Day 5: Lancaster - Gettysburg - Shenandoah Valley, Virginia - Charlottesville

Journey to Gettysburg, site of the Union victory that marked a turning point in the Civil War. A guided tour of the site illuminates those three historic days in 1863 and the decisive battle that changed the course of American history forever. Day 8: Williamsburg - Washington, D.C.

Visit Mount Vernon, the beloved home of the first U.S. president, George Washington. Wander the beautiful plantation grounds he adored and tour the home, filled with 18th century artefacts. Then, travel to Washington, D.C. Explore the world-famous Smithsonian Institution's countless treasures, containing the largest and most extensive collection of artefacts in the world, such as the fabled Hope Diamond and the actual Apollo 11 Command Module. Today breakfast will be included.

Day 9: Washington, D.C.
